- 1. You must be of Greek descent; that is, at least one grandparent must be of 100% Greek ethnicity. If necessary, you could be required to show official documentation of your Greek ancestry.
- 2. Type or print in blue or black ink all information.
- 3. Attach a resume of your academic, extra-curricular, and community service accomplishments beginning with your 9<sup>th</sup> grade year and ending with your 12<sup>th</sup> grade year.
- 4. Attach a brief, reflective essay (200-250 words) that expresses your feelings about your Greek ethnicity, its importance to you personally.
- 5. Attach two letters of recommendation to be completed by a classroom teacher, guidance counselor, and/or athletic coach/advisor. These can also be mailed separately.
- 6. Have your guidance counselor mail your most updated high school transcripts to the scholarship chairperson. Transcripts could also be included with the application.
- 7. Be sure the application, resume, Greek heritage essay, transcripts, and the letters of recommendation are submitted not later than May 4, 2012.
